<b>Implementation of thickness of less than 75 microns carry bags (virgin/ recycled) (with effect from the 30th September, 2021). (Rule 4c- August 12, 2021)</b>	The Hon'ble Chief Minister on 05.06.2018, on the floor of the Legislative Assembly, with a view to make Tamil Nadu Plastic Free, has announced, ban on 'one time use and throwaway plastics', irrespective of thickness, with effect from 1st January, 2019 under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The state has been one of pioneers in implementing the ban on plastic carry bags of all sizes and thickness. There are a number of initiatives undertaken by the state to raise awareness about teh ban, ill effects of plastic and alternatives to plastic available in the market.

## **Annexure A**

### **Implementation of Plastic Waste Management- Collection, Segregation and Disposal in the State**

There are 21 Municipal corporations, 138 Municipalities and 490 Town panchayats in Tamil Nadu. A total quantity of 3,97,387.684 tonnes (1088.734 tonnes/ day) of plastic waste has been generated during the year 2021-22 as reported by the ULBs. Out of this 95% of the waste is collected and channelized for recycling and other purposes. The total amount of plastic waste collected during the year in the State is 3,75,31.255 tonnes and half (approx.. 1.7 lakh tonnes) of collected plastic waste is channelized for recycling. Around 1028.25 tonnes/ day is collected by the ULBs and sent for recycling and processing. The ULBs carry out door to door waste collection and indulge in mass segregation practices through ULBs cleanliness staffs and contractors. The door-to-door waste collection covers a total of 1.1 crore households and around 11.7 lakh commercial establishments. The segregated waste is sent to resource recovery facilities where it is bailed and the recyclable waste is sold to the local vendors and registered recyclers for sale and the non-recyclable waste are sold to cement manufacturers for coprocessing. The waste collection and processing has been divided broadly into secondary storage, transportation, processing and disposal of waste. The maximum number (approx.. 8000) of ULB staff are employed in the secondary storage stage and approximately 1400 are employed in transportation, processing and disposal of waste.

#### ABSTRACT

Environment – 110 Announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the floor of the Assembly on 05.06.2018 regarding ban on one-time use and throwaway plastics irrespective of thickness with effect from 01.01.2019 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Notification – Orders - Issued.

#### ORDER :

The Hon'ble Chief Minister on 05.06.2018, on the floor of the Legislative Assembly, with a view to make Tamil Nadu Plastic Free, has announced, ban on 'one time use and throwaway plastics', irrespective of thickness, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

2. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in the TamilNadu Government Gazette:-

#### NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, plastic carry bags and other plastic items used in daily life cause short term and long term environmental damage and health hazard;

AND WHEREAS, Article 48-A of the Constitution of India, inter alia, envisages that the State shall endeavour to protect and improve the environment;

AND WHEREAS, it has come to the knowledge of the Government that, the use of 'use and throwaway plastics' such as plastic carry bags, plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc., plastic plates, plastic coated tea cups and plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw and plastic flags are causing serious environmental hazards and health problems amongst human beings as well as plants and animals;

AND WHEREAS, it is observed that the plastic wastes are also causing blockage of sewers and drains apart from resulting in pollution of water bodies;

AND WHEREAS, with a view to prevent the recurrence of such problems, the State Government have decided to issue the following directions imposing ban on manufacture, storage, supply, sale and use of 'use and throwaway plastics', such as,

plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc., plastic plates, plastic coated tea cups and plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw, plastic carry bag and plastic flags irrespective of thickness.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (Central Act 29 of 1986) read with Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests Notification No.S.O.152(E), dated: 10<sup>th</sup> February, 1988, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby issues the following directions:-

2. This Notification will come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2019;

#### THE DIRECTIONS

- 1.(a) No industry or person shall manufacture, store, supply, transport, sale or distribute, 'use and throwaway plastics'.
- (b) No person including shopkeeper, vendor, wholesaler, retailer, trader, hawker or salesmen shall use, 'use and throwaway plastics'.

Provided that the plastic used for the following purposes are exempted:-

- (a) The plastic carry bags manufactured exclusively for export purpose against any export order in a plastic industry located in Special Economic Zone (SEZ) and Export Oriented Units (EOU).
- (b) The plastic bags which constitute or form an integral part of packaging in which goods are sealed prior to use at manufacturing/processing units.
- (c) The plastic bags and sheets used in Forestry and Horticulture nurseries against the orders from the Government Departments.
- (d) The plastic used for packing of milk and milk products (dairy products), oil, medicine and medical equipments.
- (e) Carry bags made from compostable plastics bearing a label "compostable" and conforming to the Indian Standard IS or ISO 17088:2008 titled as Specifications for "Compostable Plastics".

- 2.(a) The Commissioners, in respect of the Municipal Corporations and the District Collectors, in respect of the local areas other than Municipal Corporations shall ensure prevention of storage, supply, transport, sale, distribution and use of the above said plastic items;
- (b) District Environmental Engineers shall ensure prevention of manufacturing of the above said plastic items.

**Explanation 1** - "Plastic" means material which contains as an essential ingredient a high polymer such as polyethylene terephthalate, high density polyethylene, Vinyl, low

density polyethylene, polypropylene, polystyrene resins, multi-materials like acrylonitrile butadiene styrene, polyphenylene oxide, polycarbonate, Polybutylene terephthalate.

**Explanation 2** – "use and throwaway plastic" means items such as plastic carry bags or plastic flags, plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc; plastic plates, plastic coated tea cups and plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw irrespective of thickness.

**Explanation 3** – "plastic sheet" means sheet made of plastic.

**Explanation 4** – "Carry bag" means bag made from plastic material, used for the purpose of carrying or dispensing commodities which have a self carrying feature but do not include bag that constitute or form an integral part of the packaging in which goods are sealed prior to use.

**Explanation 5** – The word "compostable plastic" means plastic that undergoes degradation by biological processes during composting to yield Carbon di-oxide, water, inorganic compounds and biomass at a rate consistent with other known compostable materials, excluding conventional petro-based plastics, and does not leave visible, distinguishable or toxic residue.

## **Implementation of Plastic Waste Management- Recycling, Closures of Plastic manufacturing Industries and other actions taken**

In order to enforce the Ban on Single Use Plastics and monitor the adherence to the same, frequent raids are conducted by the ULB officials and fines are imposed against the users of Single Use Plastics (SUPs). Regular IEC activities by animators and daily Door to Door collection carried out by the ULB officials. The Government of Tamil Nadu has issued a G.O. (Ms) No. 116 of Environment, Climate Change & Forest (EC.2) Department dated 27.11.2021 notifying 4 strategies to be adopted to fight plastic pollution and eliminate single use plastics, roadmap for single use plastic ban, activities for “Meendum Manjappai” campaign and proposed plans for successful implementation of the People’s campaign on one time use and throwaway plastics.

Under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 and amendment thereto, 216 nos. of Plastic waste Recyclers of capacity (as mentioned in Annexure V) approx.. 3,29,879 Tonnes per Annum. The total amount of plastic waste channelized for recycling from the total plastic waste collected is around 1,76,319 lakh tonnes. The total amount of plastic waste utilised for recycling per day is around 441 TPD. During the year, 8025 tons/ annum of non-recyclable and non-saleable plastic waste has been utilised for road construction. There are 39 compostable plastic manufacturing units (as mentioned in Annexure IX) in the State have been registered with Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board as of 31st March 2022. The list of registered Plastic Waste Recyclers and Compostable Material Producers is published and updated in TNPCB’s/ CPCB’s website regularly. The Board issued orders for closure of 50 units who were manufacturing banned plastic items.



## Overview

Government of Tamil Nadu was one of the first State to roll out a statewide single use plastic ban in 2019 banning manufacture, sales and use of 14 types of single use plastics across the state. Since, then the State has been taking consistent efforts in both enforcement of the ban and in promoting a supporting environment for the ban. Also, the State is one of the few States to ban plastic carry bags. The Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 published vide notification number S.O 249 (E), dated 4th February, 2011 by the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Environment and Forests, as amended in 2016, 2018, 2021 and 2022, provides a regulatory frame work for management of plastic waste generated in Tamil Nadu.

The State has been proactive on enforcing the ban on Single use plastic, it has issued notices to manufacturers and distributors of SUPs to stop such operations and further to it, the State has seized 1914 Tonnes of SUPs stored in commercial establishments and has instructed to close down 180 number of SUP manufacturers across the State as on September 30th, 2022. For creating a conducive environment for banning SUPs, the Government of Tamil Nadu has been equally focusing on creating awareness among general public regarding the environmental hazards caused by SUPs, the various kinds of banned plastics and probable alternatives for the banned plastic. The awareness is equally supported by enhancing the availability of alternatives to single use plastics. The government also released a detailed handbook on the SUP ban items and its alternatives.

The Government of Tamil Nadu launched the Meendum Manjappai campaign in December 2021 to create awareness among the people and to promote alternatives to plastic, alongside enforcement of ban on SUPs. Urging citizens to replace use of single use plastic carry bags with Manjappai, a traditional symbol of Tamil culture, Meendum Manjappai campaign is a massive people's campaign against throwaway plastics and, a call for returning to the basics and planning for the future. The campaign is being implemented in all districts and awareness activities are being conducted in coordination with District Collectorates and line departments. The local bodies are proactive in taking action to inspect the shops / commercial establishments to check the use of SUPs and are seizing the materials banned by the Government of Tamil Nadu. In support to the campaign and to make Manjappai available and accessible to general public, the Government of TN came up with a first of its kind cloth bag vending machine and has installed these at strategic locations like markets, malls, public building premises etc.

The number of initiatives undertaken by TNPCB has helped in channelizing a large portion of the plastic waste collected for recycling, processing and reuse. The estimated plastic waste generated for the year 2021 – 2022 from those Local bodies is around 1079 Tonnes/day, out of which 95% is collected and segregated by the respective urban bodies in which the recyclable plastic waste are sold to the recyclers and non-recyclable plastic waste are sent for co-incineration in cement plants.

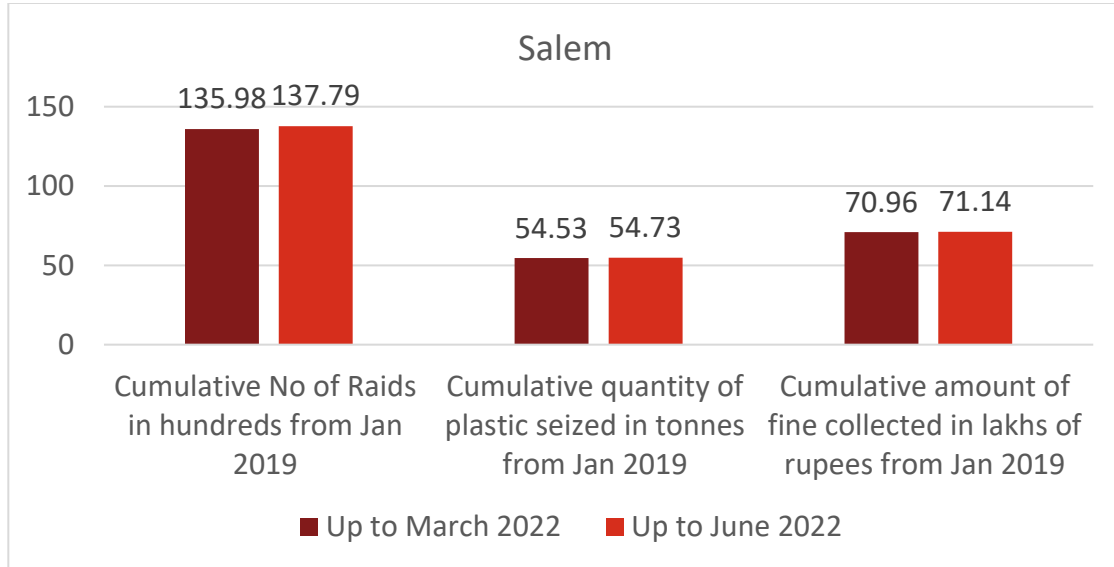

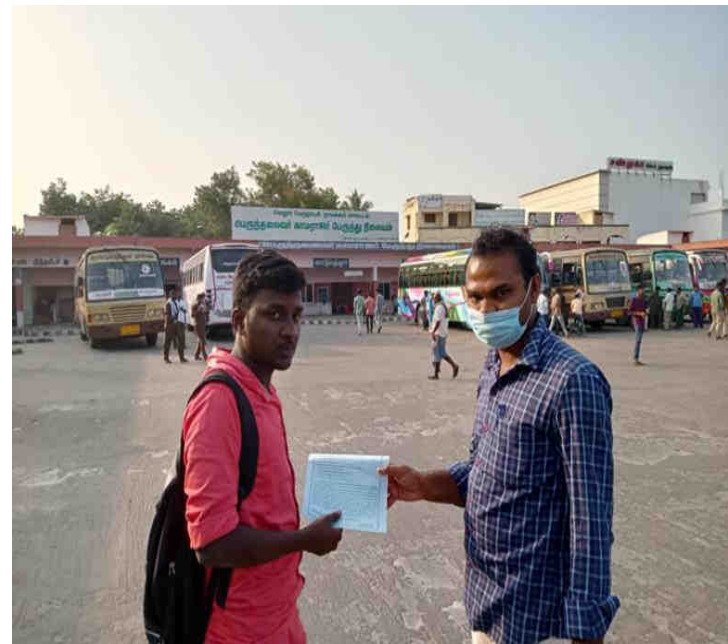

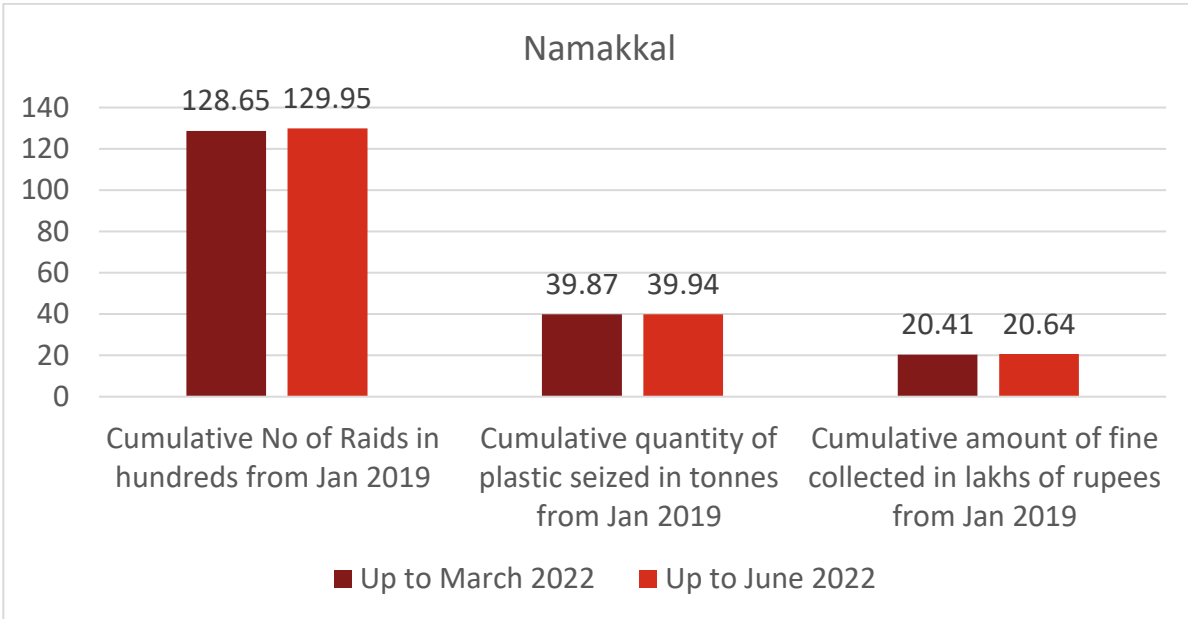

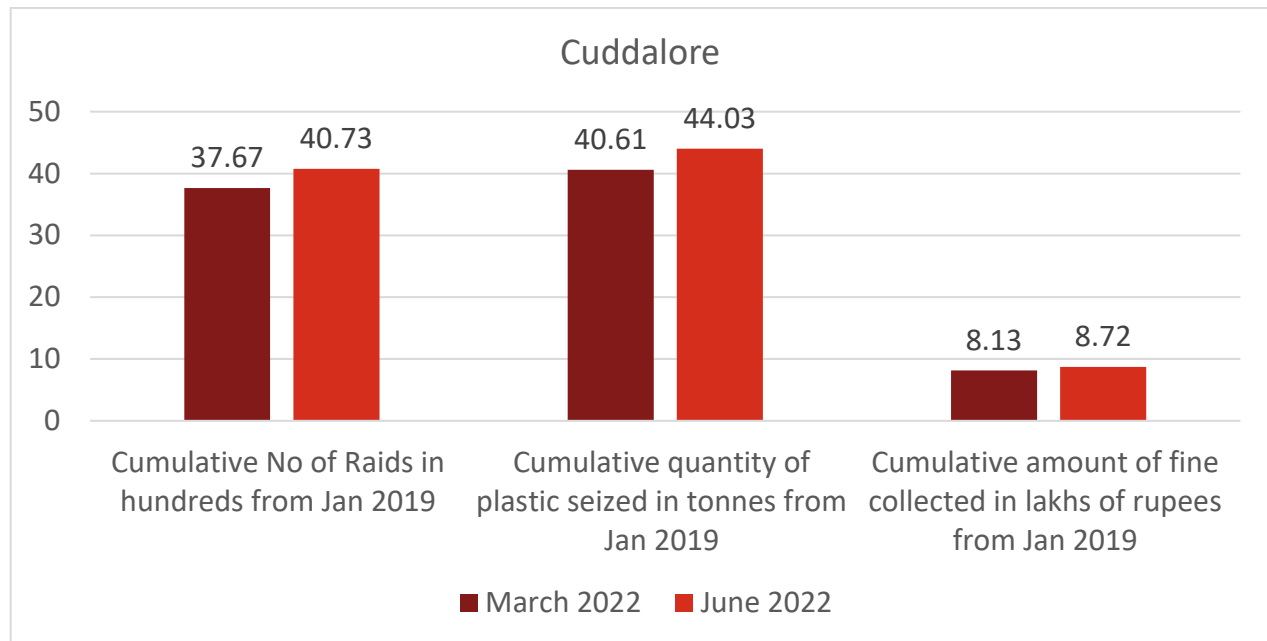

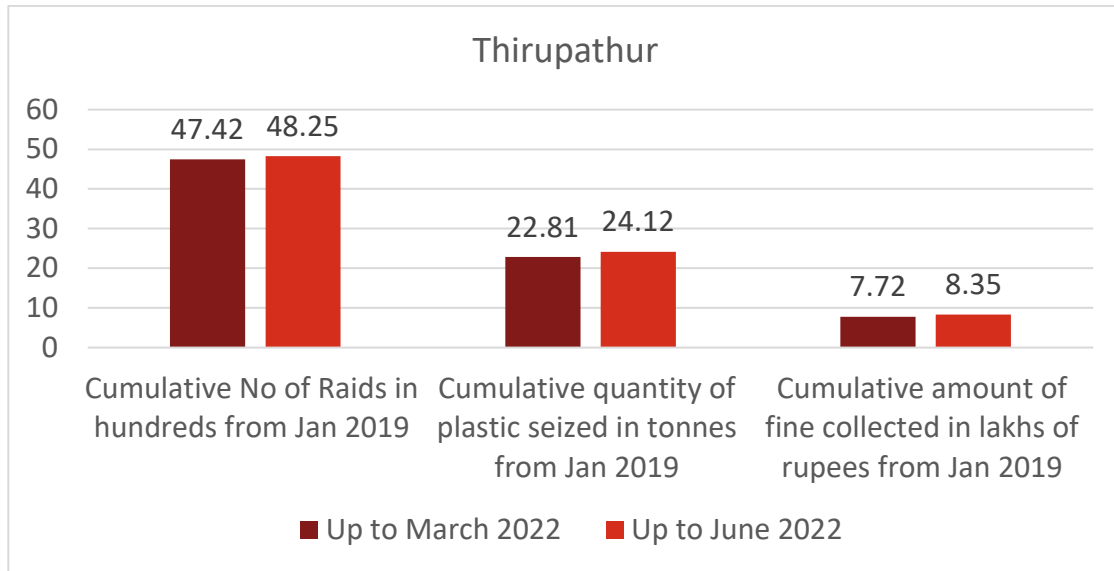

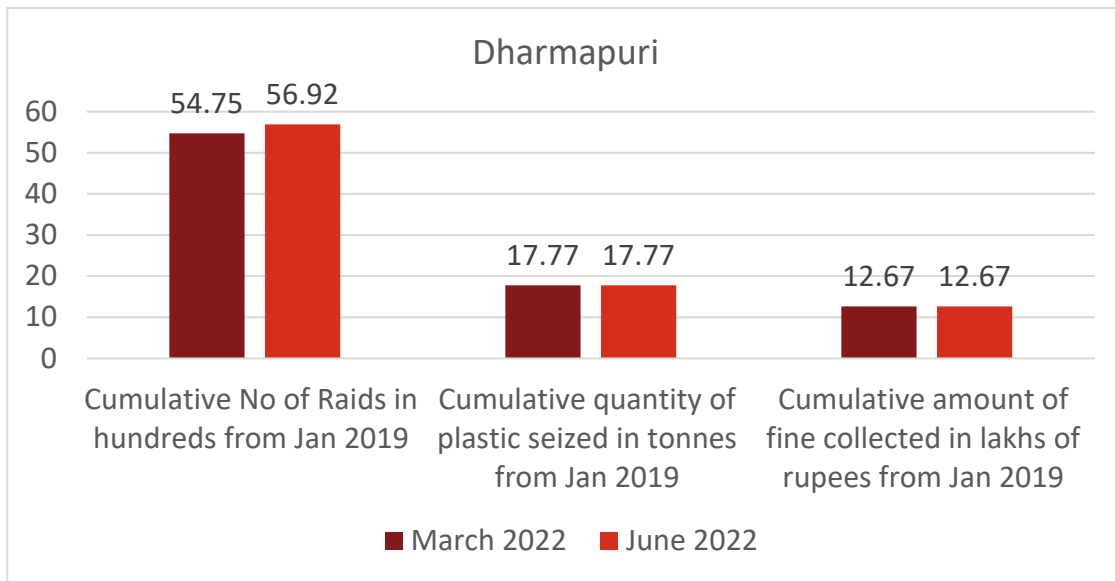

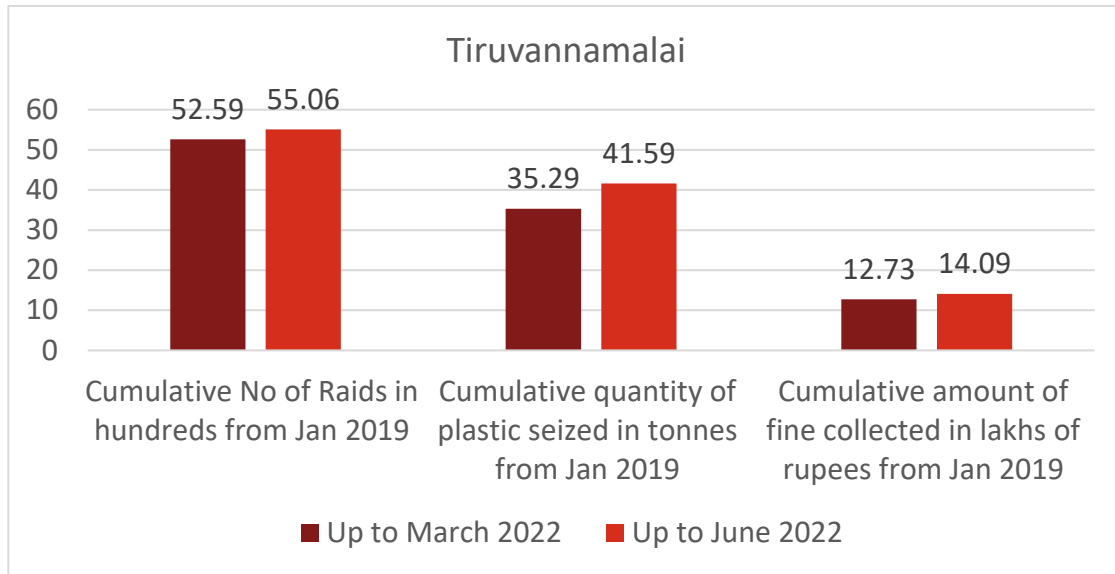

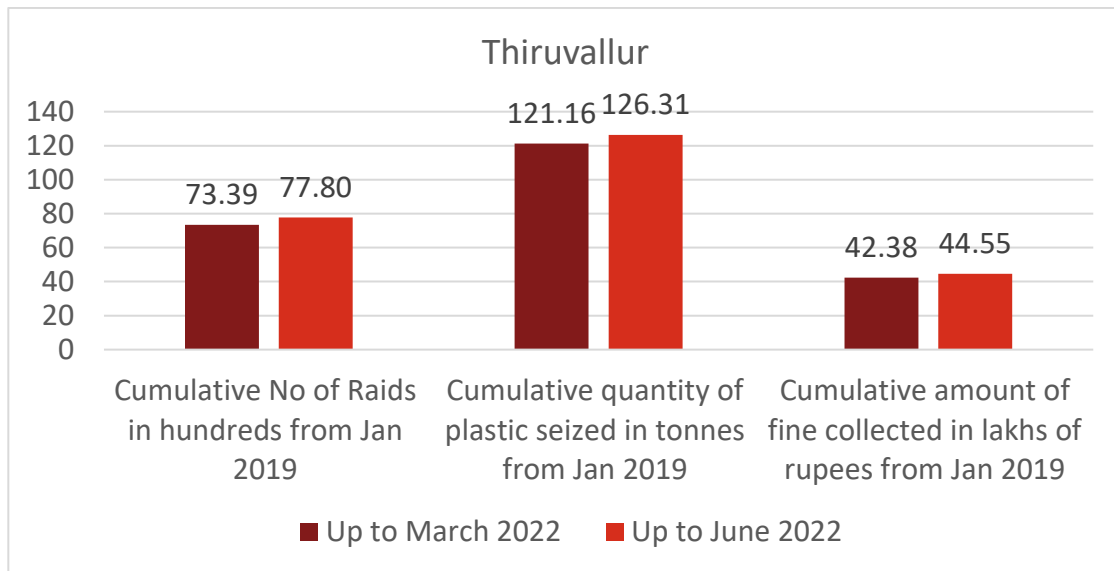
