Annexure – I

A Summary Statement on progress made by local body in respect of solid waste management

There are 21 Corporations, 138 Municipalities and 490 Town Panchayats in the State of Tamil Nadu. The total quantity of solid waste generation is 14585.49 Tons/day of which 54% is wet waste (7876.16 TPD) and 6709.33 TPD is of dry waste as reported by the local bodies out of which 14470.69 Tons/day of solid waste is being collected and 7205.57 Tons/day of solid waste is treated and 6776.31 Tons/day of municipal solid waste is land-filled in the landfill and dumpsites located in the State of Tamil Nadu. Local bodies which generate 5 TPD and above of municipal solid waste have applied for Authorisation. So far 219 applications received for authorization and Authorization issued for the said applications.

Collection, Transportation and Segregation of MSW in Tamil Nadu:

The urban local bodies at several places have organized collection of MSW by house to house collection, by using collection bins, compactor bins, lorries using dust bins, etc. All the urban local bodies have partly started the source segregation of municipal solid wastes generated in their limits and are partly composting the biodegradable waste. Transport facilities such as dumper placer, tipper lorry, tipper tractor, trucks, etc. have been used by the Corporations for transportation of wastes and in some cases the vehicles are closed or pneumatic compactors are used in few corporation areas. Similarly, Municipalities and Town Panchayats utilize the transport facilities such as tractor trailer, dumper placer, tipper, tricycle, push carts etc.

Solid waste Processing Facilities in Tamil Nadu:

In the state of Tamil Nadu, various waste processing facilities like windrow composting, Vermi composting, Micro Compost Centres (MCC), Onsite Composting (OCC), Bio Methanation, Material recovery facilities and Incineration plants are being followed.

- 1054 MCC sanctioned to process 3820 TPD of wet waste in 21 Corporations and 138 Municipalities and 39 Town panchayats. So far, 995 MCCs with handling capacity of 3569 TPD have been established. In Greater Chennai Corporation, 1 Bio CNG plant is functioning to process 100 TPD. 4 Garden waste & tender coconut shells processing plant of 320 TPD capacity and 2 Windrow composting centers are established with processing capacity of 100 TPD. 907 OCCs are established in Corporations & Municipalities having handling capacity of 350 TPD for waste to composting facilities.

- 107 Biomethanation plants are established to process 259 TPD of Wet Waste. 527 Windrows composting plants and 27 Vermi Composting plants are functioning with capacity of 1355 TPD.

The Overall Processing percentage of wet waste = 75% (5907.12 TPD) of total wet waste of 7876.16 TPD.

- To dispose the dry waste generated in ULBs, 439 numbers of Material Recovery Facilities/Resource recovery centres have been sanctioned.
- 72,130 Tonnes of non-recyclable wastes generated are sent to cement plants/ sugar mills/ power plants for usage as fuel.
- In Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC), incinerator of capacity 50 TPD – 1 No. & 10 TPD – 1 No. are under operation.

Scientific Landfill sites and dumpsites:

In the State of Tamil Nadu, 4 landfills have been constructed and the same have been capped. Nearly 210 dumpsites are in existence in the State of Tamil Nadu. Bio Mining works for legacy wastes has been completed in 69 locations and cleared 32 lakh Cu.m of legacy waste and 360 acres of land has been reclaimed. In 111 locations, works are under progress.

Monitoring of MSW facility:

TNPCB collects samples of ground water in the vicinity of the dumpsites and samples of leachate from the dumpsites, as one of responsibilities of monitoring the compliance of standards regarding ground water, ambient air, leachate quality.

Ground water quality is monitored at the vicinity of solid waste dumpsites pertaining to Corporations namely, Chennai, Erode, Madurai, Coimbatore, Trichy, Erode, Vellore, Nagercoil, Dindigul, Hosur, Thanjavur, Salem, Tirunelveli, Thoothukudi, Kumbakonam and Avadi and 64 Municipalities.

Ambient Air quality monitoring is monitored at the vicinity of solid waste dumpsites pertaining to Corporations namely, Chennai, Coimbatore, Vellore, Madurai, Nagercoil, Trichy and Dindigul.

Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring stations are installed at the vicinity of Kodungaiyur and Perungudi dumpsites

Formation of Committees

State Level Advisory Body as per SWM Rules, 2016

State level Advisory Body is formed as per G.O. (MS). No. 5 MA& WS (MA.IV) Department dated: 25.01.2017 under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Municipal Administration & Water Supply Department comprising of 19 members including TNPCB. State level Advisory Body Meetings have been conducted on 16.03.2017, 21.03.2018, 25.02.2019, 5.4.2019, 20.11.2019, 17.08.2020 & 16.09.2022.

State Monitoring Committee as per Hon'ble NGT order dated 16.01.2019

As per the Hon'ble NGT order dated: 16.01.2019 in O.A. No. 606/2018, State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) in Tamil Nadu was constituted and functioning under the Chairmanship of Dr. P. Jyothimani, Former Judge, Madras High Court, Former Judicial Member, National Green Tribunal.

Action taken by the TNPCB:

Issue of Directions and Environmental Compensations:

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (Principal Bench) vide order dated 28.02.2020 & 02.07.2020 in OA No. 606 of 2018 has directed that "In view of the fact that most of the statutory timelines have expired and directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and this Tribunal to comply with Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 remain unexecuted, Interim compensation scale is hereby laid down for continued failure after 31.03.2020".

- As per the orders of the Hon'ble NGT (PB) in OA No. 606 of 2018 dated 02.07.2020, TNPCB assessed Interim Environmental Compensation based on CPCB's template and issued Directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 with respect to remittance of Interim Environmental Compensation to the following urban local bodies

Solid Waste Collection:

The urban local bodies at several places have organized collection of solid waste by house to house collection, by using collection bins, compactor bins, lorries using dust bins, etc. All the urban local bodies have partly started the source segregation of municipal solid wastes generated in their limits and are partly composting the biodegradable waste. Transport facilities such as dumper placer, tipper lorry, tipper tractor, trucks, etc. have been used by the Corporations for transportation of wastes and in some cases, vehicles are covered or pneumatic compactors are used in most of the Corporation areas. Similarly, Municipalities and Town Panchayats utilize the transport facilities such as tractor trailer, dumper placer, tipper, tricycle, push carts etc. In most urban local bodies the biodegradable wastes are composted using Micro Compost Centres (MCCs), Windrows, Biomethanation plant and segregated non-biodegradable of non-recyclable nature waste is sent to cement industries for co-incineration and recyclable waste is sent to waste recyclers and remaining waste is dumped in dump yards.

House to house collection of solid wastes is completely carried out in 17 Corporations namely Hosur, Avadi, Nagercoil, Coimbatore, Tirunelveli, Thanjavur, Trichy, Madurai, Salem, Vellore, Dindigul, Kumbakonam, Kancheepuram, Karur, Sivakasi, Tambaram & Cuddalore and at 114 Municipalities

Segregation of Solid Waste:

Segregation of solid wastes is completely carried out in 5 Corporations namely Hosur, Trichy, Thanjavur, Thoothukudi, Karur and 16 Municipalities.

Most of the Corporations, Municipalities and Town Panchayats in the State of Tamil Nadu have been instructed to adhere to the standards prescribed in schedule II of the Municipal Solid Waste Rules, 2016 without fail.

TNPCB collects samples of ground water in the vicinity of the dumpsites and samples of leachate from the dumpsites, as one of responsibilities of monitoring the compliance of standards regarding ground water, ambient air, leachate quality, TNPCB also conducts Ambient Air Quality survey at the landfill site and at their vicinity.

Ground water quality is monitored at the vicinity of solid waste dumpsites pertaining to Corporations namely, Chennai, Erode, Madurai, Coimbatore, Trichy, Erode, Vellore, Nagercoil, Dindigul, Hosur, Thanjavur, Salem, Tirunelveli, Thoothukudi, Kumbakonam and Avadi and 64 Municipalities.

Ambient Air quality monitoring is monitored at the vicinity of solid waste dumpsites pertaining to Corporations namely, Chennai, Coimbatore, Vellore, Madurai, Nagercoil, Trichy and Dindigul.

Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring stations are installed at the vicinity of Kodungaiyur and Perungudi dumpsites

Urban Local Bodies are adopting Micro Compost Centre (MCC) methodology for composting in which the leachate generated is recycled. Hence, leachate characteristics is not analysed at these facilities.
